- * We strongly recommend that you teach the memory verse after the lesson because it gives the teacher ample time to deal with those seeking salvation. However, if it simply does not work in your situation, you may teach it before the lesson. There are a few times when you *must* teach the memory verse last, otherwise the verse gives away the whole plot of the lesson. In these cases, you will be instructed specifically to teach the lesson first. Please be sure to do so.
